# Installation Instructions CTTF 7 day Fused Time Controller

To be read in conjunction with **Supply MASTER** installation and operating instructions

This unit gives a convenient way of providing a time controlled power supply for appliances up to 3kW by direct connection or above via a suitable relay/contactor. It incorporates a 13A fuse and double pole isolator switch with a 7 day programmer. The contacts are volt free but can be easily linked to give a 230Vsupply.

The unit is suitable for directly switching up to a 13A resistive load such as a 3kW fan or convector

The unit can be used to provide the time controlled supply for the RCHx-xxxxTT recessed ceiling heaters. These heaters incorporate integral relays thus removing the need for external contactors to control multiple units.

## **ELECTRICAL CONNECTIONS for use with RCHx-xxxxTT**

To provide a 230V output Terminal 2 and Terminal 3 should be linked.


Connect incoming supply to Terminal 5 - neutral and Terminal 6 - live.

Connect heater **T1** and **T3** to Terminal **4**.

If the thermostat requires a neutral it should also be connected to Terminal 4

Connect heater **T2** and thermostat input to Terminal **1**. If the thermostat is not required connect heater **T4** directly to Terminal **1**.

Maintain earth continuity through connector provided.




