PIR Version

Automatic operation:

- The light will turn on when walking through detection range (see below)
- The light will turn off after 60s when there is no movement detected

Manual Over-ride

- Turn the unit on for 5 seconds and switch offon twice in 2 seconds. The unit will stay on, bypassing the sensor.
- Turn off the unit for 10 seconds, the unit will be back to automatic operation mode.
